



Create a Marketing & Awareness Plan

1 Month in Advance



Begin Awareness Campaign at Parish Bulletin Announcements/Inserts, Mass Announcements, Events, Educational Materials, Targeted Homilies

Advertise for Sensory-Friendly Liturgies



Reach Out to Local Organizations

Plan the Liturgy (Get Pastor Approval)

Organize Liturgical Ministers

Train Liturgical Ministers

1 Week in Advance

Day of Sensory-Friendly Mass



- Print & Laminate Adaptive Materials
- Communicate with Liturgical Ministers
- Meet with Planning Committee
- Check with Pastor RE: Homily

- Set Up Sensory Room
- Put out Adaptive Materials, Fidgets, Noise Cancelling Headphones, Etc.
- Adjust Lighting
- Run a Sound Check with Lectors, Priest, Deacon and Cantor
- Make a Welcome Announcement
