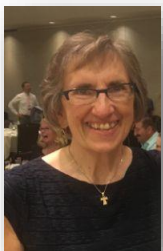

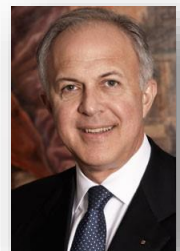

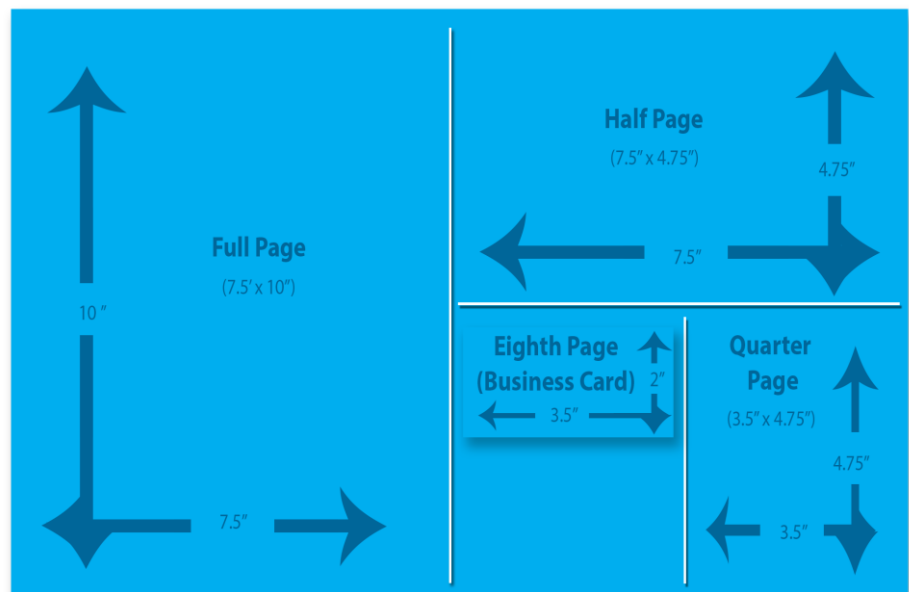
What types of ads will be included?
